1	2.1 Purpose, page 7	<p>Near the end of the opening paragraph, the RFP states, "MDCPS plans to invest the resources at its disposal in concert with private and public partners to leverage and maximize resources to provide a comprehensive Transportation and Driving Pilot Program for eligible foster youth ages 15 and older for services such as gaining education on transportation types, getting a regular learner's permit and/or regular driver's license within the state of Mississippi to include actual driving experience." Does this actual driving experience need to be provided by the provider, or may a subcontractor provide this service? A subcontractor approved by MDCPS may be used for actual driving experience. If a subcontractor may provide this service, what type of information regarding the subcontractor(s) should be included in the RFP proposal? A letter of intent as noted in the last service bullet under Section 2.2, and all requirements specified in the RFP as it relates to the utilization of subcontractors.</p>
2	2.1 Purpose, page 8	<p>The second bullet point in 2.1 purpose states, "Can provide all Core Service Components of the comprehensive Transportation and Driving Pilot Program statewide.". Will an agency centrally located who provides didactic driver's education remotely (phone conversations, video conference, etc.) and utilizes subcontractors to provide actual driving experience meet the statewide requirement? Yes, however, proposers should assure that the proposal details how all services would be offered and provided by both the subgrantee and the subcontractor.</p>
